Cornwall energy recovery centre, St Dennis

At the energy recovery centre, a high-quality educational visit will inspire curiosity and fascination amongst pupils about new waste management strategies in Cornwall, and the wider world.

Visits and additional online resources due to COVID-19

Following government COVID-19 guidelines, tours of the Cornwall energy recovery centre and Bodmin materials recycling facility can currently only accommodate small groups of up to six visitors safely.

For larger groups, we are offering one-hour bookable virtual presentations and tours hosted by our Education and Community Officers. They will take you through the waste journey in Cornwall, look at ways to reduce the rubbish we create in the first place and think of ways to reuse items before they are recycled or thrown away.

We have videos showing how our waste facilities work and animations to support the learning around recycling and energy-from-waste. They are a great, free resource to support learning about waste and our environment.
